End of Year Letter

At the end of my 2nd term since arriving, following the change of Trust at the academy, I am extremely happy with the progress we are making and with the magnificent support we have received from parents. However, we still have lots of work to continue to grow Smestow Academy into the magnificent school we know it can be. This will be helped greatly by the excellent staff appointments we have made for September, with 13 teaching staff joining and only 2 substantive members of teaching staff leaving. This means we will not be required to bring any supply or short term contract staff to cover our curriculum or to deal with occasional unplanned staff absences. It also gives us the capacity to significantly reduce class sizes in Years 9, 10 and 11 for next academic year.

This letter is intended to provide the necessary information you will need for your child to be ready for September 2023.

Uniform

We remind you of the following expectations (some of them changes) to the uniform from September 2023.

- Shoes should be black leather and polishable (details of acceptable and unacceptable footwear can be found at https://smestowacademy.co.uk/uniform/)
- All trousers and skirts should be plain black (grey will no longer be accepted)
- Girls skirts need to be an appropriate length (approximately 5cm above the knee)
- Optional jumpers under the blazer should be plain black V-neck jumpers (no more navy blue; jumpers should not replace blazers)
- No piercing are permitted other than small silver or gold stud in each ear lobe (No nose studs, false nails/eyelashes or extreme hairstyles)

Equipment

In order to be fully prepared for learning we ask that pupils bring to school each day 2 black pens (one spare), green pen, pencil, ruler, scientific calculator and their pupil planner which will be distributed on return in September.

Medical Conditions

If your child has a medical healthcare plan that has been written by a medical professional, please bring a signed copy of this in to school. Additionally, please contact school reception on Tuesday 5 September to arrange for you to bring in the required medication and to complete the relevant paperwork with one of our First Aiders. We are unable to administer medication prior to written consent being obtained from parents/carers.

<u>Cashless Catering and Parental/Carer Communication</u>

From September 2023, Smestow Academy will be going cashless and all payments will be made on our new Matrix Academy Trust App which can be downloaded on your mobile device app store. This is where you will make payment for your child's catering and any additional trips you wish for them to attend. All credit and trip payment history on your child's Parentpay account will be transferred over to the new app ready for September. In the last few weeks of the summer, you will receive an email or message stating your child is enrolled – please follow the instructions and sign in to your child's account. Please note, your child will not be able to purchase anything in the school with cash when they return. If you do not plan on making payments, please still download the app as this will contain day to day information for you from school.

Year 11 Study Seminar

In order to support our Year 11 learners in achieving the best outcomes in their Summer 2024 examinations, we will be running compulsory study seminars for Year 11 from 3:00 to 3:50 after school. These will begin on the week commencing 11th September and will alternate weekly with from **one week Tuesday – Maths, Wednesday – English and Thursday – Science** (Monday night on this week will be staff training so Year 11 pupils will finish at 3:00) and a **second week of Monday – Option D block subjects, Tuesday – Option C block subjects, Wednesday – Option B block subjects and Thursday – Option A block subjects.** The focus of these sessions will be on modelling and







teaching study and revision skills as well as providing additional guidance on how to answer examination style questions.
